Use commentino to make your voice heard on the web. The following chapters will show you how.

commentino publisher is a little piece of software that publishes all you comments to one web page - that's commentino.com/yourname.

You can use commentino:

- As a backup for all the content you write on various web sites
- As a log that you can share with your friends
- As a public information log that people can find by using search engines or by searching at www.commentino.com
- As an RSS feed you can re-use in your blog, web site, social network, or any other application that supports RSS

Use the power of commentino to keep your user-generated-content yours and make your voice heard on the web.

The next chapters describe how you download, install and use commentino.

Downloading, installing and creating a commentino account

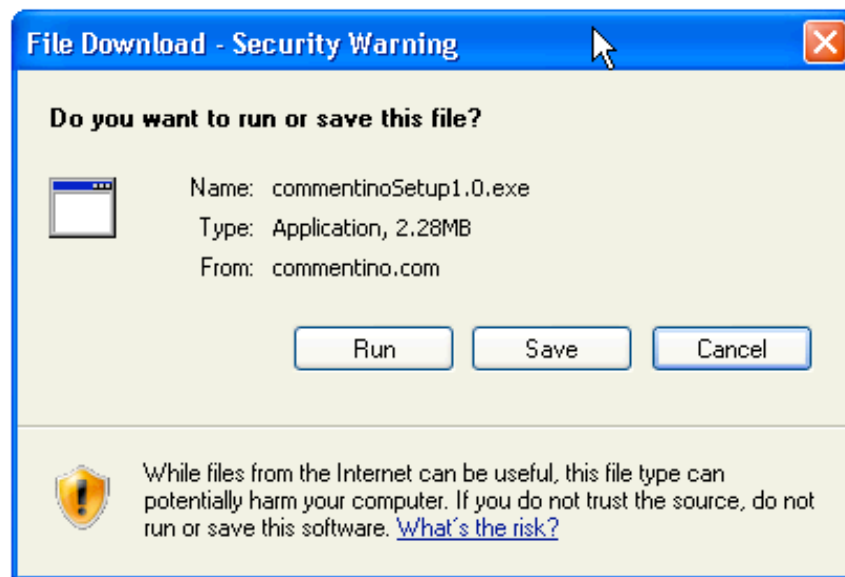
This chapter includes information about the three easy steps you need to complete before commentino is ready for publishing

Downloading commentino

To download commentino, follow the next steps:

- Go to <http://www.commentino.com> and click on the download link
- Run the commentino Setup application

A window will open asking what you want to do with a file called commentinoSetup1.0.exe You might see a confirmation message, asking if you're sure you want to run this software. Click 'Run' again



Installing commentino

Right after downloading commentino, a Setup Wizard will open automatically. Follow the Wizard to install commentino.

Note: during the installation process, you will be asked to read and accept commentino's End User License Agreement and commentino's Privacy Statement. You can view both by clicking the help button on the Wizard or by going to <http://www.commentino.com/info/terms.html>

Creating a commentino account

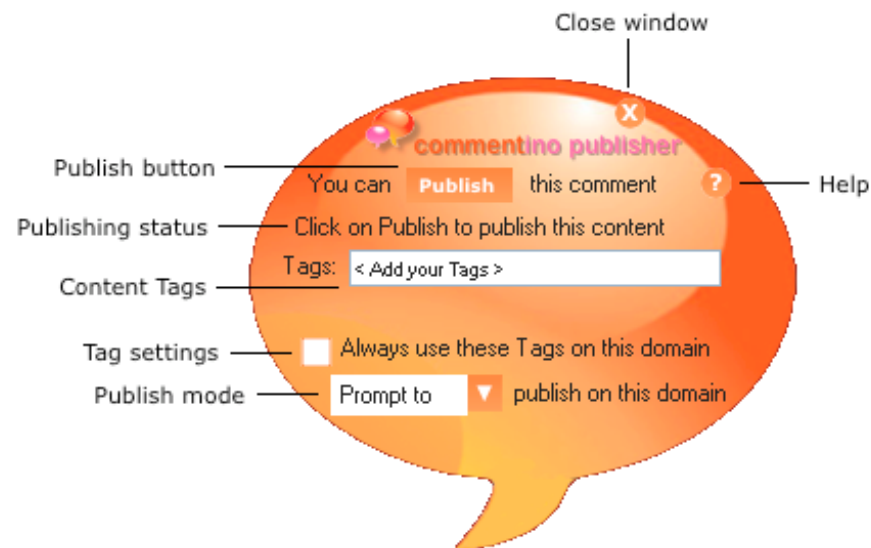
When installation completes, the Create New Account Wizard will automatically start. Follow the Wizard to create a new account.

Note: during the creation of a new commentino account, you will be asked to read and accept commentino's End User License Agreement and commentino's Privacy Statement. You can view both by clicking the help button on the Wizard or by going to <http://www.commentino.com/info/terms.html>

That's all, now you're ready to go with commentino!

This chapter contains information about manual and automatic publishing of your content and adding Tags to the content you publish.

When you write a comment anywhere on the web, commentino will display a small black “bubble” window and offer you a few ways to publish your content; it will also offer to skip publishing if you prefer not to publish this content. commentino modes are saved per each domain you visit:



Learning mode

Whenever you browse to a new web domain (one that you didn't work with commentino in), commentino will start in Learning mode by default. This mode offers you to publish your content, but does not publish it automatically. In case you ignore commentino's window, it will not publish the content. While in Learning mode, you can do the following:

- Ignore commentino's window: your content will not be published. After you ignore commentino's window three times, commentino will automatically learn you do not wish to publish content on this domain and will change to Never Publish mode
- Publish your content by pressing the Publish button. You will notice that Publishing status changes to "This content will be published".

- Add tags to your published content and check or uncheck the option to always use this tags when you publish on this domain.
- Change the publish mode on this domain:
 - After you publish once on a domain, the default mode will be: “Prompt to publish on this domain” and it means that each time you write content, commentino will offer you to publish it, but will not publish until you click the Publish button.
 - Choosing the “Always publish on this domain” mode, tells commentino to automatically publish any content that you publish on this domain. You have the option to skip a specific content item if you do not wish to publish it. You also have the option to decide, after publishing, you want to remove a specific content item (see “commentino settings” chapter).
 - Choosing the “Never publish on this domain” mode, tells commentino to never publish on this domain. You can change this setting later (see “commentino settings” chapter).

Prompt to Publish mode

This mode tells commentino that each time you write content, commentino will offer you to publish it, but will not publish until you click the Publish button.

Always Publish mode

This mode tells commentino to automatically publish any content that you publish on this domain. You have the option to skip a specific content item if you do not wish to publish it. You also have the option to decide, after publishing, you want to remove a specific content item (see “commentino settings” chapter).

Never Publish mode

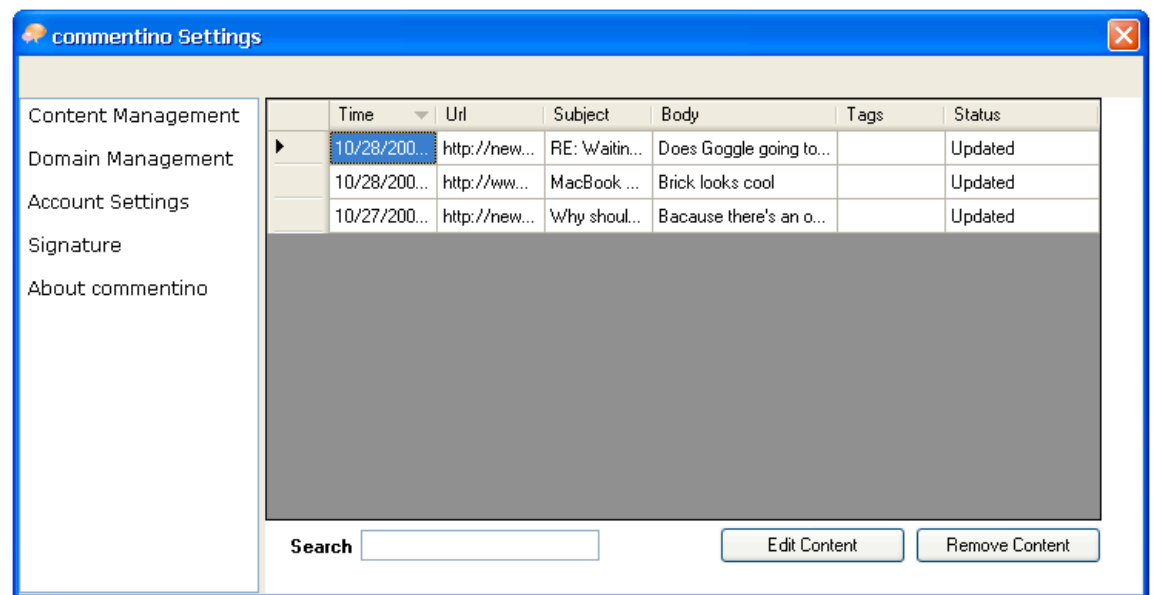
Choosing the “Never publish on this domain” mode, tells commentino to never publish on this domain. You can change this setting later (see “commentino settings” chapter).

commentino let you control your published content, domain settings, a personal signature and more

Opening the Settings window

To open commentino's Settings window, right click the commentino icon at Window's tray, and choose Settings.

Content Management

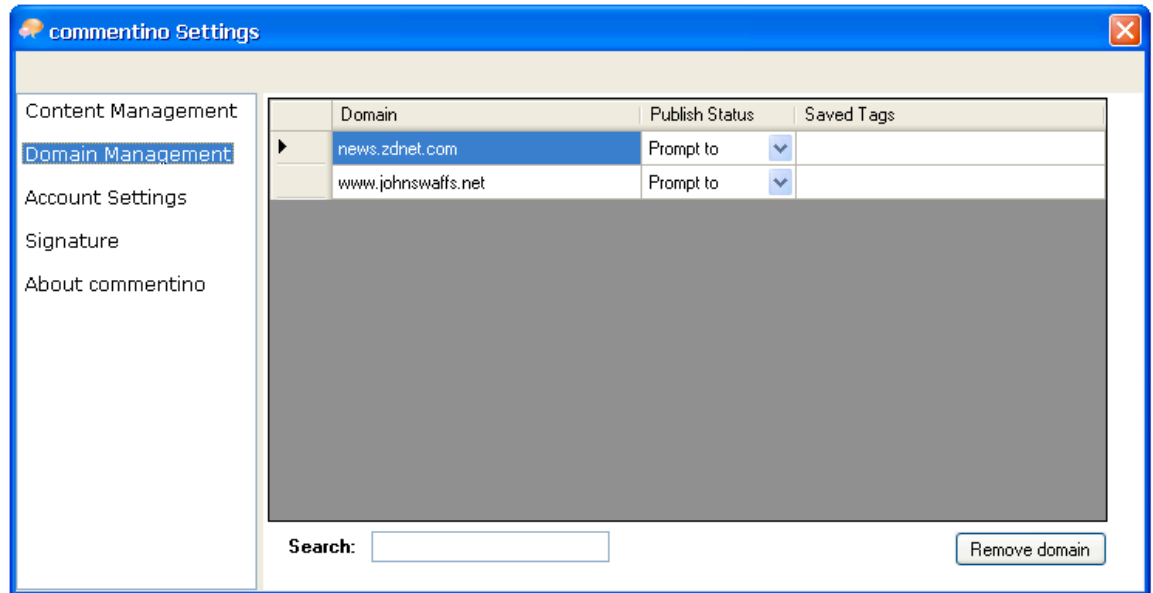


The Content Management section displays the comments you've published on commentino. It also enables you to edit or remove specific comments.

The table shows the following columns:

- Time: this is the time in which you've published the content
- URL: displays the URL of the page in which you've published the content
- Subject: the subject of your content, if there's one. For example: the subject of a comment to an article on the web
- Body: the body of your content
- Tags: if you've added Tags to your content, automatically or manually, they will be displayed here
- Status: shows the publishing status of your content
 - Publishing
 - Published
 - Removing

Domain Management



For each web page you write content in, commentino will set a publishing status for the domain and list of Tags that you have saved for use in this domain.

commentino uses the following domain published statuses:

- Learning: as soon as you start to write data at a new domain, commentino will offer you to publish the content you write in this domain - this mode is called Learning mode. In case you don't publish for three times in this domain, commentino will automatically guess that you do not want to publish content at this domain and will change to mode "Never".
- Prompt: in this mode, commentino will ask you each time if you wish to publish content. commentino will not publish any content unless you click the Publish button.
- Always: in this mode commentino will automatically publish content. This mode best fits domains in which you want all your content to be public and available on www.commentino.com. In this mode, commentino will offer you the option to skip publishing a specific content item, but will publish content as a default.


- Never: in this mode, commentino bubble does not show and content is not published. Changing this mode to another mode (i.e., Prompt or Always) is available from Domain Management only.

You can change the status for each domain by using the list of values in the status column.

Each time you publish content, commentino offers you to add Tags to that represent category or context for your content. commentino also offers you to save these Tags if you want to use them again on the same domain. You can view and edit your saved Tags for each domain under the Tags column in Domain Management.

Use the search option to search for specific domains in your Domain list.

Account Settings

Here's what you can do in this screen:

- Sign In or Sign Out from commentino: to Sign In you will be asked to enter your commentino name and password. In case you want commentino to Sign In automatically as you start commentino, check the option: Remember Me.
- Disable and Enable commentino: from time to time, you may want to browse the web without having commentino offering you to publish your content. In that case, you can disable commentino temporarily. When commentino is disabled it will not

offer you and will not publish any content. When you want to enable commentino, just click the Enable button.

- Retrieve forgotten password: in case you forgot your password, click this button to have your password emailed to the email address you've registered with to commentino.
- Sign Up: in case you've downloaded commentino and did not register, click this button for a short and easy registration wizard.

Edit Profile

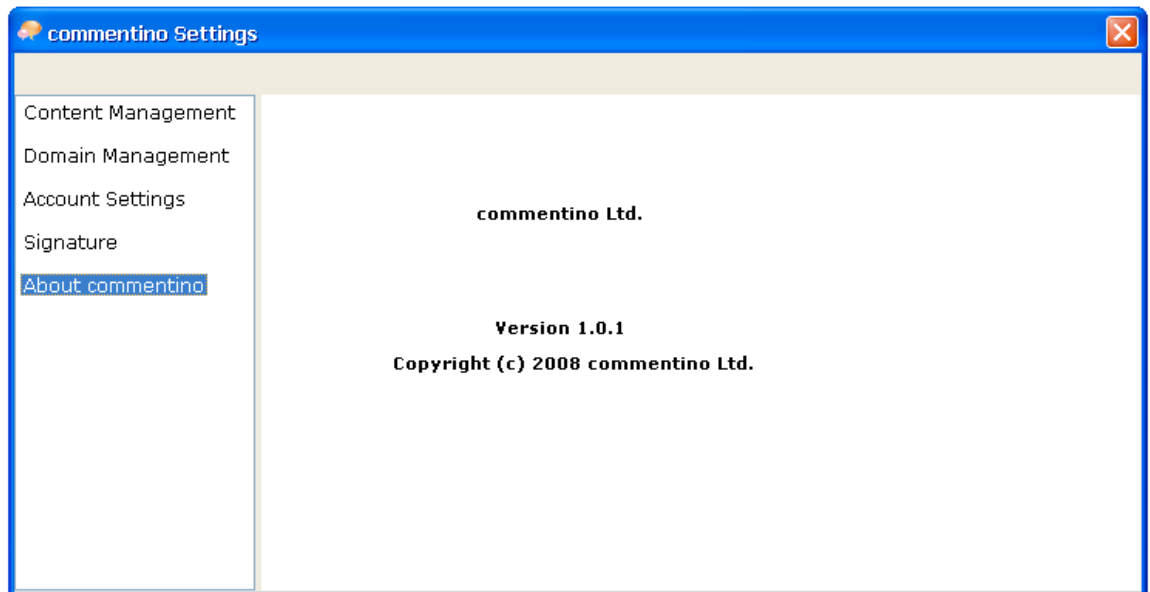
Set up your personal information here, and it will show up on www.commentino.com.

commentino client gives you full control over the information you send to your page at www.commentino.com. When you install commentino, it will ask you each time you publish a comment on the web, if you would like to publish it to commentino as well. Here are just a few examples:

- If you visit a web site in which you never want to publish content, you can set its Publish Status to “Never publish on this domain”, and commentino will never ask you and never publish anything on this domain.
- If you visit a new domain three times and do not publish any content, commentino will automatically set its status to “Never publish on this domain”.
- When you visit a secured web page (one that starts with https), commentino will not offer you to publish your content
